Directions to venue

Travelling From the South on the A1 North

Exit A1 North at Junction 49 taking the A168 heading for Teesside and the A19.

Keep on the A168 which eventually becomes the A19.

When you have passed the turn off for Knayton, and then Borrowby, you will shortly come over the brow of a hill, you should see a sign in the middle of the dual carriageway on the right for Leake Church, as you have passed this sign, you take the next left turn onto Cotcliffe Bank heading for Crosby.

Keep on this road, it winds down into a wooded valley, and then you cross over a small stone bridge and as the road begins to head uphill take your next right onto the road for Bank Head Farm and Bank Top Farm.

The road splits into two, take the left-hand fork into Bank Top Farm, continue up towards the farm buildings and the barn for parking.



Pet friendly places to stay are detailed below.

Note that the trial weekend is either side of the bank holidays and accommodation bookings may get more expensive closer to the trial date.

TD Rally® eligibility

All competitors must be registered with TD Rally® prior to competing at any sanctioned TD Rally® trial. To register, contact the Office or go to the website and download the form and send it with payment to the [TD Rally® office](#).

Everyone over the age of 7 years (when attending trials children under 16 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian) on the date of the trial is eligible to compete once registered with TD Rally®.

All breeds of dogs, crosses and mixes of breeds over 6 months old on the date of the trial can compete. Health and behaviour may exclude dogs from competing but breed type does not.

Competing Levels

Puppy is for dogs aged between 6 and 18 months on the date of the trial.

Level 1 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial.

Veteran Level 1 is for dogs over 7 years on the date of the trial.

Pre Level 2 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Pre Veteran Level 2 is for dogs 7 years and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Level 2 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Veteran Level 2 is for dogs 7 years and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Level 3 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 2 Title or Championship and who are working towards their first Level 3 Title.

Veteran Level 3 is for dogs 7 years and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 2 Title or Championship and who are working towards their first Level 3 Title.

Terms & Conditions

- ❖ Each team, a team consisting of one dog and one handler, must hold a valid Talking Dogs Rally® (TD Rally®) registration. Teams with disabilities must have submitted a Disability Modification Form to the Talking Dogs Rally® Office prior to the Trial or along with their Trial application form. Disability Modification Forms will not be accepted on the day of the Trial.

- ❖ No unregistered substitutions for handler or dog are permitted.

- ❖ The Trial will be held outdoors on grass for all levels.
- ❖ By entering this Trial, competitors acknowledge and agree to abide by the rules, terms and conditions as laid out by Jayne Crowther and Talking Dogs Rally®.
- ❖ The Trial hosts reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason. Refunds cannot be guaranteed for entries withdrawn or dismissed for any reason but may be given depending on circumstances. If the Trial has to be cancelled for any reason, we will refund entry fees if possible but this is not guaranteed. If the trial host cancels the trial, the trial host will refund all trial fees in full to registered competitors within 14 days of the trial date. If Talking Dogs Rally® cancels the trial, the trial host will refund all trial fees in full to registered competitors within 14 days of the trial date.
- ❖ The Judge's decision is final; rudeness to judges will not be tolerated.
- ❖ Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry.
- ❖ Your team may not compete if your bitch comes into season immediately prior to or during the Trial. Do not bring your dog to the Trial if s/he is ill or injured, or has been infected with, or has been in contact with another dog infected with, a contagious disease.
- ❖ If your pet is ill or suffers an injury during the Trial, please notify the Trial Organisers.
- ❖ Competing in Talking Dogs Rally® is a physical activity and as such Handlers are reminded to work with due care and attention to their own safety and that of others. Handlers are responsible for the conduct of their dog at all times.
