

The Vet on Mull is located at Lagganulva Farm, Ulva Ferry, PA73 6LT – the Vet on the island is available for emergency situations and the dog may need to be taken to them. Telephone 01688 500139 in the first instance.

Duart Castle

Duart Castle is a very popular destination and there is a café and gift shop on site. At times the café can get very busy. If you intend to use the café for lunch, please indicate this on the trial entry form so that we can collate numbers and advise the café in advance. A tour of the castle is highly recommended.

Please note – the weather conditions for Islands off the West Coast of Scotland are unpredictable. The trial venue is on a high crag at the end of a peninsula overlooking the Sound of Mull – this location can be subject to strong winds, and also glorious sunshine. Please ensure you bring sufficient clothing options to cater for all weather conditions.

Livestock

The land around Duart Castle is used for grazing livestock. Please keep your dog on a lead within the castle grounds and surrounding areas.

Directions to venue

FROM CRAIGNURE FERRY

Turn left as you exit the ferry terminal, heading for Fionnphort and Iona.

Approximately 1.5 miles ahead of you on your left, you will see a large sign for the castle – take the left turn in front of this sign onto a single-track road – heading for Kilpatrick.

The castle is approximately 1.5 miles along this road, the car park and the location of the trial are on the right-hand side.

Competitors are asked to park considerately and as directed by the trial host as this is a popular destination for island people and tourists.

DRIVING ON THE ISLE OF MULL

The majority of the roads are single track – please use passing places to pull over into the left side of the road to allow faster vehicles behind you to overtake – and also to pull into/or reverse into if there is an oncoming vehicle in front of you that does not have a passing place to use.

Please be mindful that other people may be travelling to catch a departing ferry.



These need to be booked in advance via the CalMac website. Note that CalMac control when booking opens up for specific periods throughout the year and you may need to keep checking back to see when the period of the trial will open for bookings.

TD Rally® eligibility

All competitors must be registered with TD Rally® prior to competing at any sanctioned TD Rally® trial. To register, contact the Office or go to the website and download the form and send it with payment to the TD Rally® office.

Everyone over the age of 7 years (when attending trials children under 16 years old must be accompanied by a parent or guardian) on the date of the trial is eligible to compete once registered with TD Rally®.

All breeds of dogs, crosses and mixes of breeds over 6 months old on the date of the trial can compete. Health and behaviour may exclude dogs from competing but breed type does not.

Competing Levels

Puppy is for dogs aged between 6 and 18 months on the date of the trial.

Level 1 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial.

Veteran Level 1 is for dogs over 7 years on the date of the trial.

Pre Level 2 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Pre Veteran Level 2 is for dogs 7 years and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Level 2 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Veteran Level 2 is for dogs 7 years and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 1 Title or Championship.

Level 3 is for dogs 1 year and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 2 Title or Championship and who are working towards their first Level 3 Title.

Veteran Level 3 is for dogs 7 years and older on the date of the trial. This level is for handlers who have already won a TD Rally® Level 2 Title or Championship and who are working towards their first Level 3 Title.

Terms & Conditions

Each team, a team consisting of one dog and one handler, must hold a valid Talking Dogs Rally® (TD Rally®) registration. Teams with disabilities must have

submitted a Disability Modification Form to the Talking Dogs Rally® Office prior to the Trial or along with their Trial application form. Disability Modification Forms will not be accepted on the day of the Trial.

- No unregistered substitutions for handler or dog are permitted.
- The Trial will be held outdoors on grass for all levels.
- By entering this Trial, competitors acknowledge and agree to abide by the rules, terms and conditions as laid out by Paws by the Loch Dog Training and Talking Dogs Rally®.
- The Trial hosts reserve the right to refuse any entry for any reason. Refunds cannot be guaranteed for entries withdrawn or dismissed for any reason but may be given depending on circumstances. If the Trial has to be cancelled for any reason, we will refund entry fees if possible but this is not guaranteed. If the trial host cancels the trial, the trial host will refund all trial fees in full to registered competitors within 14 days of the trial date. If Talking Dogs Rally® cancels the trial, the trial host will refund all trial fees in full to registered competitors within 14 days of the trial date.
- ❖ The Judge's decision is final; rudeness to judges will not be tolerated.
- Returned cheques do not constitute a valid entry.
- Your team may not compete if your bitch comes into season immediately prior to or during the Trial. Do not bring your dog to the Trial if s/he is ill or injured, or has been infected with, or has been in contact with another dog infected with, a contagious disease.
- If your pet is ill or suffers an injury during the Trial, please notify the Trial Organisers.
- Competing in Talking Dogs Rally® is a physical activity and as such Handlers are reminded to work with due care and attention to their own safety and that of others. Handlers are responsible for the conduct of their dog at all times.
